Anna's Gingerbread Cookie Recipe

Ingredients:

- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
 - 1 teaspoon baking powder
 - 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
 - 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 1 1/2 teaspoons ground ginger
 - 1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
 - 1/2 teaspoon ground cloves
 - 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened
 - 1/2 cup brown sugar, packed
 - 1/2 cup molasses
 - 1 large egg
 - 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- Icing sugar and colorful sprinkles for decoration



In a bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda, salt, ginger, cinnamon, and cloves.

In another bowl, beat the softened butter and brown sugar until creamy. Add the molasses, egg, and vanilla extract, and mix until well combined.

Gradually add the dry ingredients to the wet ingredients and mix until a dough forms.

Divide the dough into two portions, wrap them in plastic wrap, and chill in the refrigerator for at least 1 hour.

Preheat your oven to 350°F (175°C) and line baking sheets with parchment paper.

Roll out the dough on a floured surface to about 1/4-inch thickness.

Use gingerbread man and star-shaped cookie cutters to cut out the cookies.

Place the cookies on the prepared baking sheets and bake for 8-10 minutes, or until the edges are slightly golden.

Let the cookies cool completely, then decorate with icing sugar and colorful sprinkles.

Enjoy creating and sharing these delightful gingerbread cookies, reminiscent of Anna Warner, author of "Jesus Loves Me".

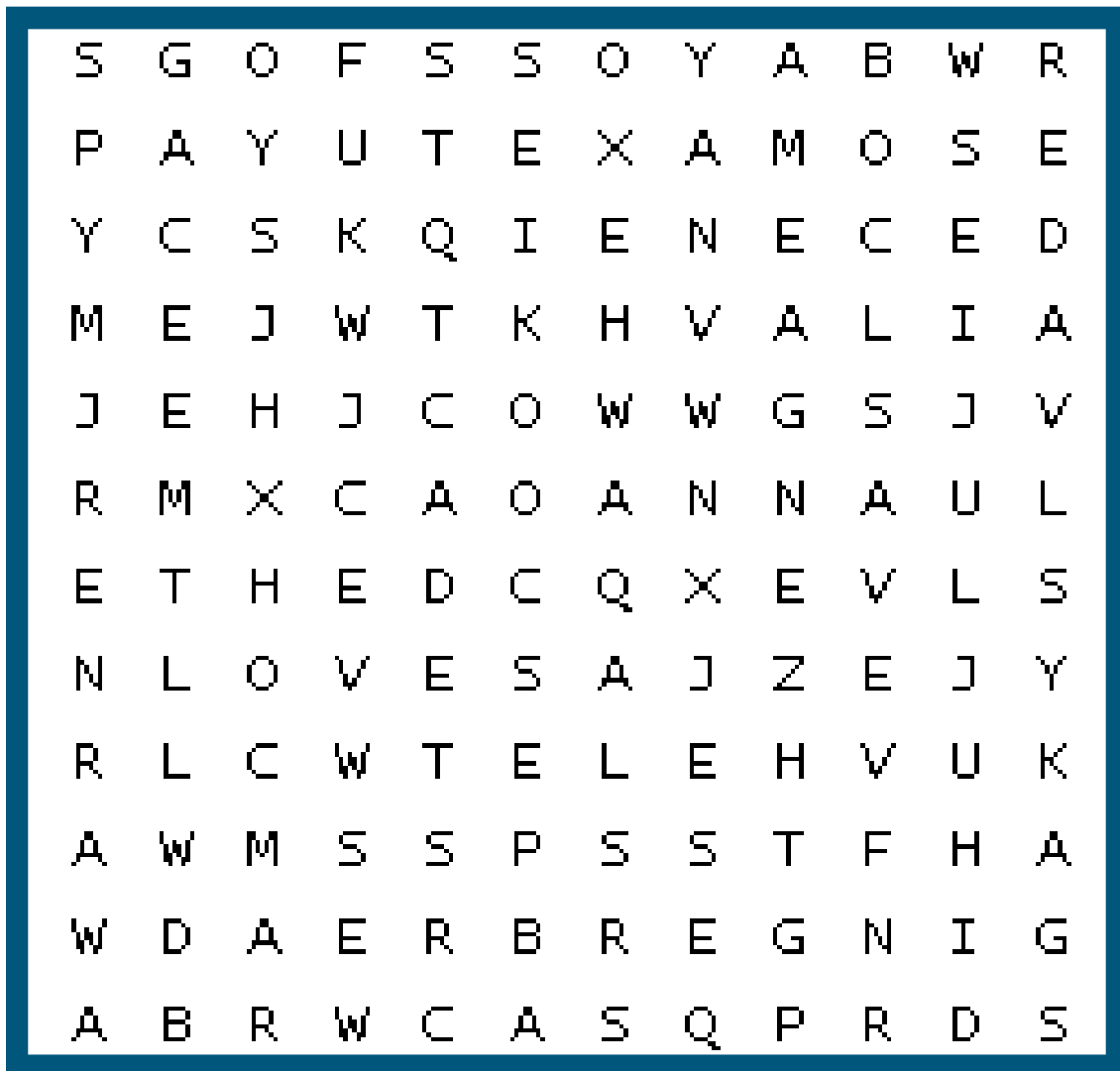




Jesus Loves Me Word Search

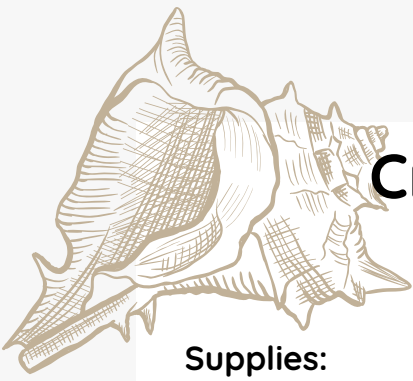

Create a Delightful Panda Bear from a Seashell

Supplies:

- A clean scallop seashell.
- Acrylic paints (black and white).
- Paintbrushes of varying sizes.
- Clear sealant.
- Construction paper or felt (for the ears).
- Craft glue or a hot glue gun.
- Scissors.



Instructions:

Base Painting: Start by applying white acrylic paint over the front of the scallop seashell. Let it dry thoroughly.

Eyes: With a round brush, paint two prominent black circles on the seashell's upper half for the panda's eyes. Inside these circles, add a smaller white circle to give the eyes a twinkling effect.

Nose and Smile: Design a small black upside-down triangle in the center for the nose. Below the nose, draw a gentle curve to represent the panda's cheerful smile.

Ears: Cut out two small ear shapes from the black construction paper or felt. Attach these to the seashell's top section using craft glue or a hot glue gun.

Sealant: Once your design has set, brush on a clear sealant over the painted seashell for added protection and a glossy look. Allow it to dry completely.

Optional: String for Hanging: Cut a 6-inch piece of string and tie its two ends together to form a knot. Squeeze a small amount of hot glue onto the back of the seashell at the top center. Carefully press the string's knot into the glue, ensuring it's securely attached.
